Route Notes

When you leave camp, you will take Harbor Blvd. through Ventura, Point Hueneme and Oxnard. From there you will go back to the coast on the Pacific Coast Highway to Santa Monica. Please ride single file. Be particularly cautious in Malibu where typically there are many parked cars along the shoulder (Code for Surfers). You will enter a bike path at Temescal Canyon that will loop under the PCH at Will Rogers State Beach. You will then head East into Los Angeles and travel city streets where traffic may be heavy at times. This will take you directly to the holding site in West Hollywood.

Please remember that all Rest Stop closure times will be strictly enforced so that everyone may arrive on time for the Closing Ceremony

Destination: West Hollywood

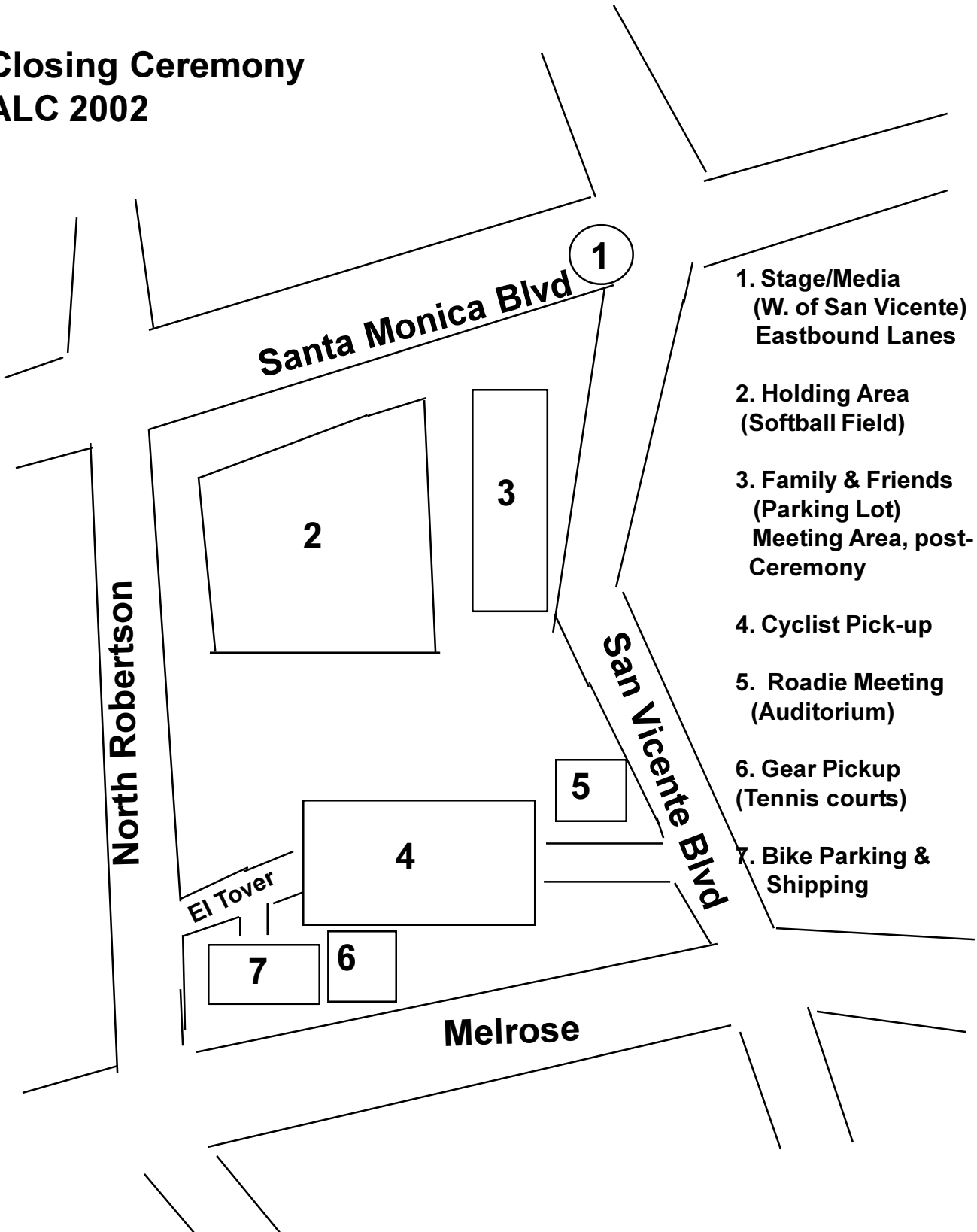

Closing Ceremony

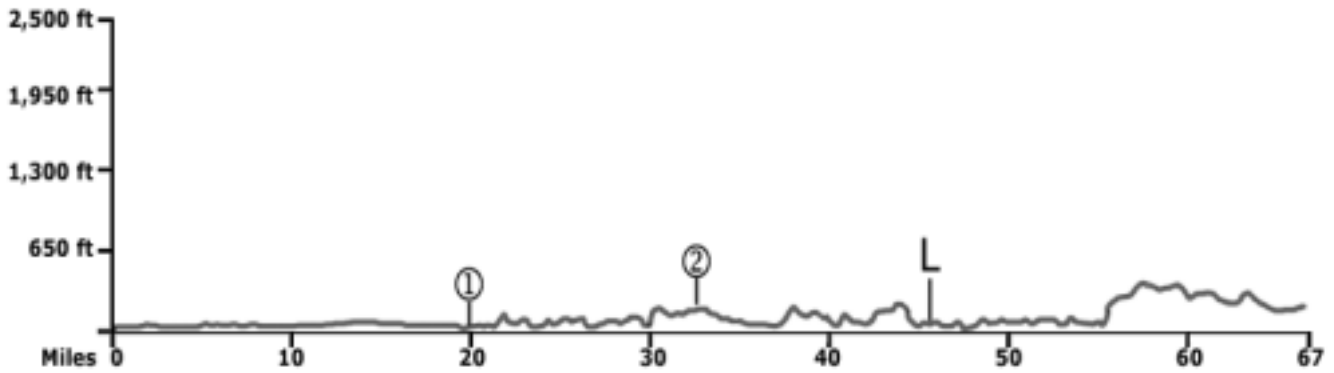
- 10:00am** Holding Area opens
